Hospitality in a 17th century large country house which has maintained

it's noble characteristics after restructural work in 2005. This was the

preferred house of many noted artists, some of whose works are still to be found here.

**Bedrooms:** Large beamed rooms, complete with antique furniture, each with bathroom and kitchen, next to a large veranda for breakfasting and a terrace with panoramic views.

**The Garden:** Spacious garden including large lawn, barbeque area for tranquil dining under the stars, a Swimming and a Pallaio. There is an internal square for parking.

**Where to find us:** Popolano (Marradi) is situated in the hills on the Tuscan-Romagnolo Appenines in the province of Florence. It is easily accessible, even by public transports.

**Price** per person per night from Euro 23.00 to Euro 40,00

Price per person for breakfast: from Euro 3.00 to Euro 5.00

Cost for use of kitchen (breakfast and other meals) per person per day: from Euro 1,00 to Euro 3.00.

It is also possible to rent a single room at a cost from Euro 30,00 to Euro 45.00 per day, a triple room (for 3 persons) from Euro 70,00 to Euro 87,50, or a quadruple room (for 4 persons) from Euro 85,00 to Euro 119,00.

The town of Popolano (Marradi) offers splendid opportunities to discover the local ancient forests and monasteries either on foot or horseback.
